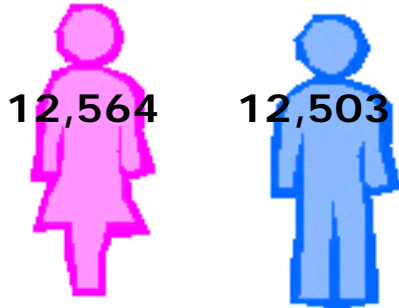




## 2006 Data Profile for Alliance for Families and Children

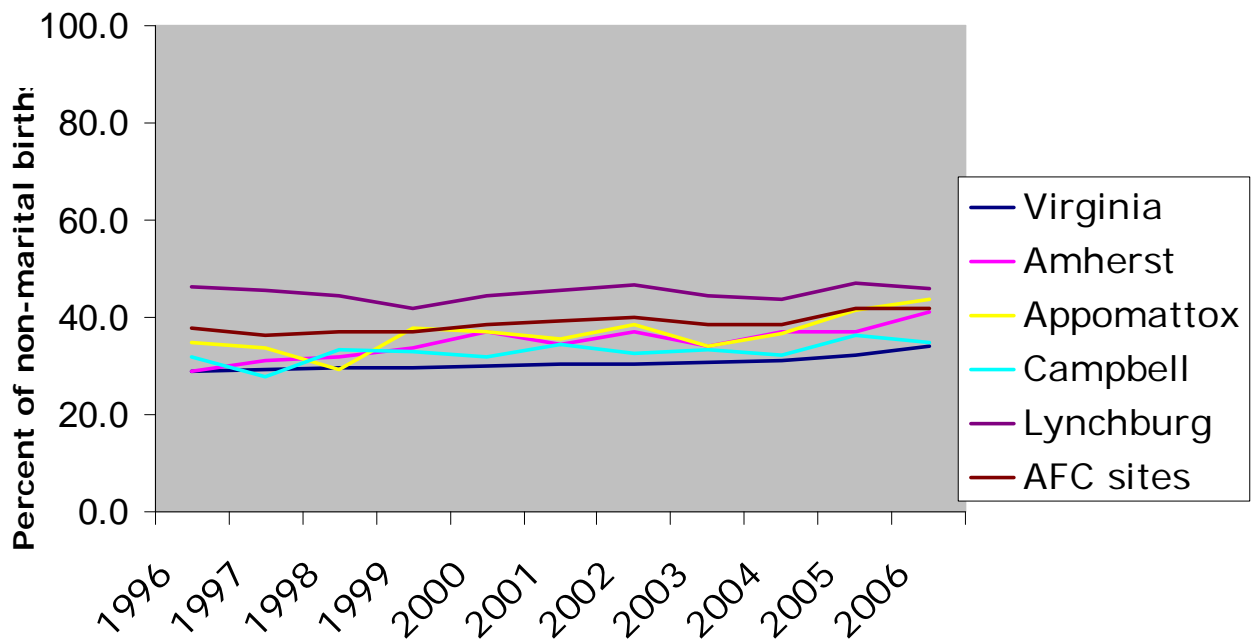

- Target population: Single men and women aged 20 to 29 years.
- Alliance for Families and Children (AFC) serves the counties of Amherst, Appomattox, Campbell, and the city of Lynchburg.
- In the cities and counties served by the AFC, 43.2 percent of women aged 20-29 years were unmarried at the time of birth in 2006.

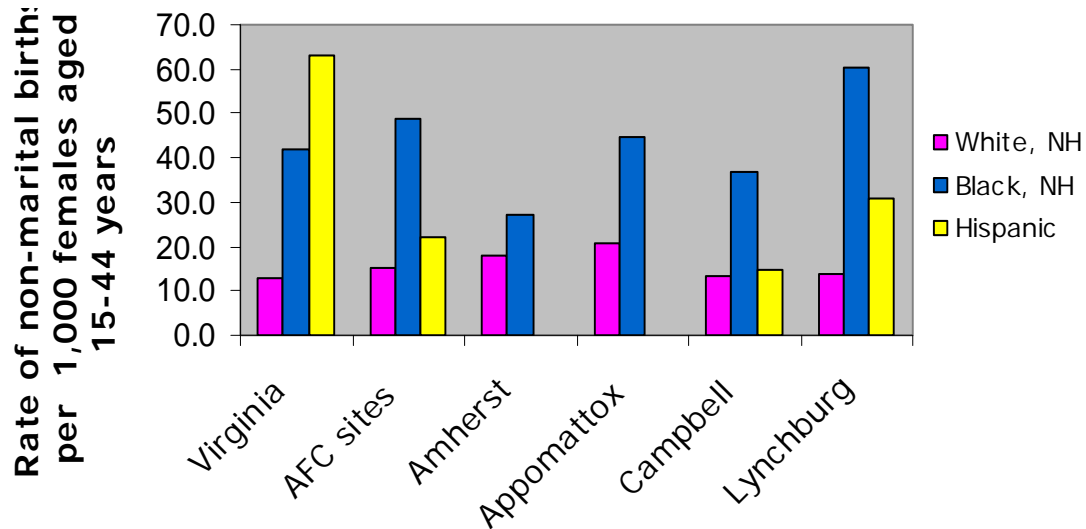
### Non-marital birth trends, 1996-2006
