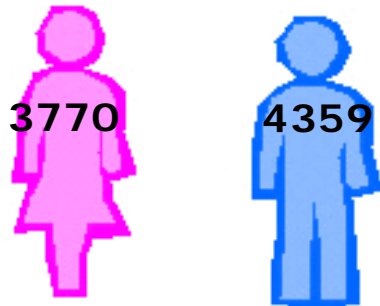




2006 Data Profile of For the Children PIP

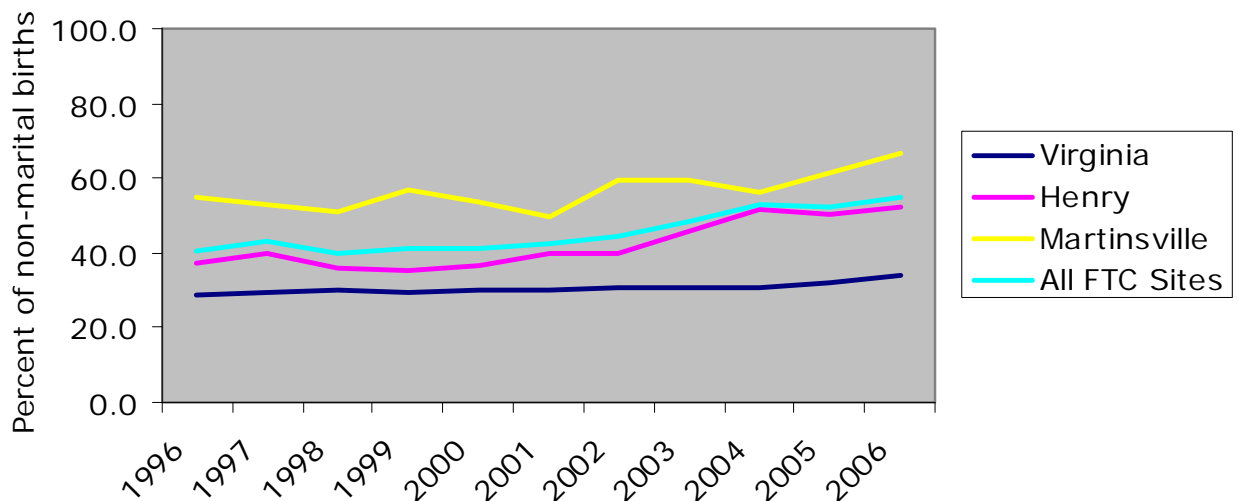

- In the city and county served by the FTC, 57% of women aged 20-29 were unmarried at the time of birth in 2006.

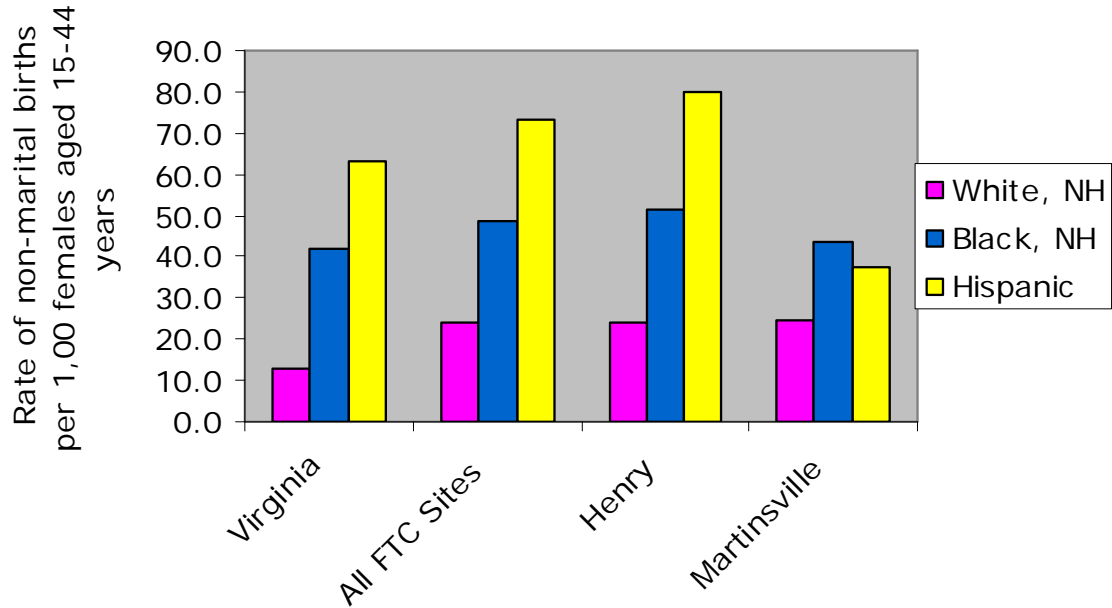
Non-marital birth trends, 1996-2006
