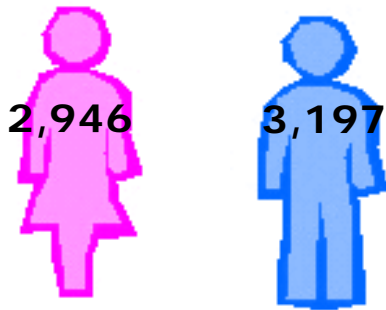




2006 Data Profile for Twin County Prevention Coalition

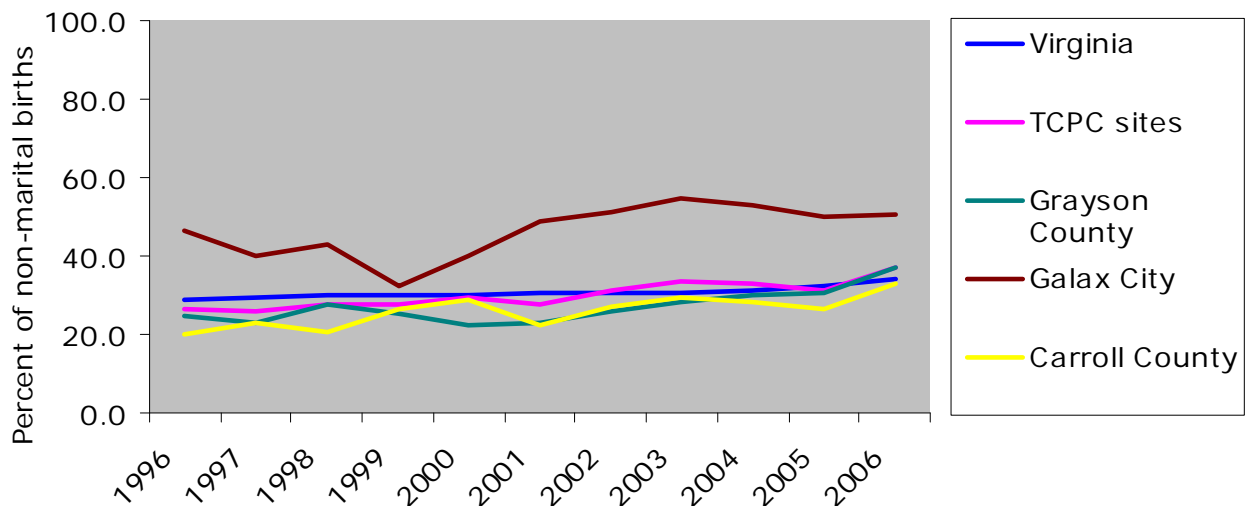

- In the cities and counties served by the TCPC, 37.2% of women aged 20-29 were unmarried at the time of birth in 2006.

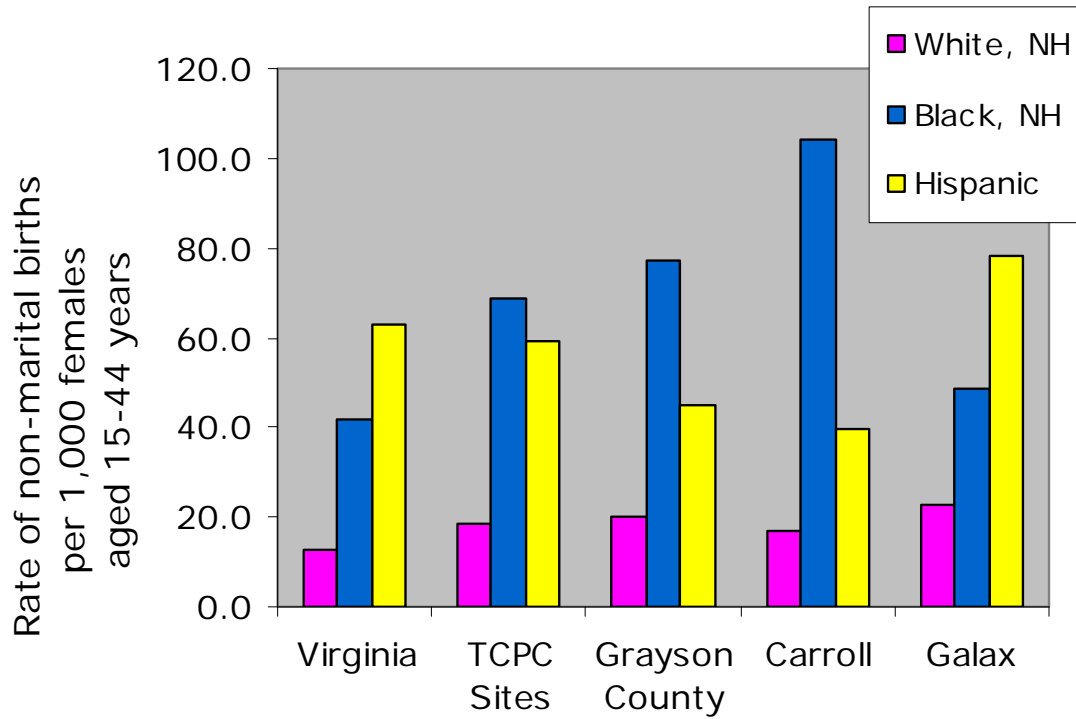
Non-marital birth trends, 1996-2006
