**The Virginia Department of Health's Office of Family Health Services (OFHS)** consists of 50 programs, which are under five divisions and one center.

- ◆ Child and Adolescent Health
- ◆ WIC and Community Nutrition Services
- ◆ Dental Health
- ◆ Chronic Disease Prevention
- ◆ Center for Injury & Violence Prevention

The mission of the OFHS is to provide the leadership, expertise and resources that enable all of Virginia's residents to reach and maintain an optimal level of health and well being. Program managers work closely with other areas of VDH, such as the Office of the Chief Medical Examiner, the Office of Health Policy, and the Office of Epidemiology. Information has been obtained from all of these areas and correlated together for the making of the **Division of Women's and Infants' Health, Perinatal Guidelines and Resources.**
